## Gospel Summary (1 Corinthians 15:1-8)--the story upon which we "have taken our stand" (verse 1)

- 1. "Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures" (v3)
- 2. he was buried (v 4)
- 3. he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures (v 5)
- 4. he appeared to Cephas...the Twelve...more than five hundred brothers and sisters...James...all the apostles...to me also, as to one abnormally born. (v 5-8)

"But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect. No, I worked harder than all of them—yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me" (1 Corinthians 15:10).

- 1. "I am what I am" (conversion)
- 2. "I worked harder than all of them" (calling)

## Grace's First Move: "I am what I am"

I used to be: persecutor, hater, ignorant, kingdom of darkness

Now I am: Christian, saved, redeemed, missionary, teacher, preacher, writer, bi-vocational ministry, apostle, disciple, leader, etc.

Grace's 2nd Move: "I worked harder than all of them." In the span of 20 years (46-66AD) Paul:

- 1. Visited 50 cities and towns
- 2. Started 20+ churches
- 3. Travelled 10,000+ miles
- 4. Travelling 300+ days
- 5. Cost: 1600+ denarii

"I have worked much harder, in prison more frequently, been flogged more severely...Five times I received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was pelted with stones, three times I was shipwrecked, I spent a night and a day in the open sea, I have been constantly on the move...I have labored and toiled and have often gone without sleep; I have known hunger and thirst and have often gone without food; I have been cold and naked" (2 Corinthians 11:23-27).

God's grace does not make us passive. God's grace does not make us apathetic. Rather, Grace creates toil, energy and the unleashing of dreams

Here are the 2 things that Christians says:

- Do you see me? Do you see the kind of person that I am?—it's all grace
- Do you see me? Do you see the work that I do?—it's all grace
