"Truth" vs truths"

A Watershed Moment (John 6:60-71)

"Lord, to whom shall we go? [assumption: there is no where else to go]. You have the words of eternal life." [assumption: because there is no where else to go, you alone have the words of eternal life]

The Context Of Unbelief

- "On hearing it, many of his disciples said, "This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?" (verse 60).
- "Very truly I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you..." (verses 53-56)
- "...his disciples were grumbling..." (verse 61).
- "From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him" (John 10:66).

Why Does Peter Say This?

"I saw you while you were still under the fig tree before Philip called you." (John 1:48)

"Fill the jars with water"; so they filled them to the brim. Then [Jesus] told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet." (John 2:7-8).

"Go," Jesus replied, "your son will live." The man took Jesus at hisword and departed." (John 4:50)
