"Christ Is Risen!—He Is Risen Indeed!"

The Luckiest Person In The World...?

• The embarrassing detail?

1. The Stone Was Removed

"Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb **and saw that the stone had been removed from the entrance**" (verse 1)

- Something has happened!
- Why is the stone rolled away?

2. The Strips Of Linen

"Then Simon Peter came along behind him and went straight into the tomb. **He** saw the strips of linen lying there, as well as the cloth that had been wrapped around Jesus' head. The cloth was still lying in its place, separate from the linen" (verses 6-7).

OR: "...not lying with the linen cloths but folded up in a place by itself" (ESV)

• Would "body snatchers" leave the linen clothes behind?

3. A New Mercy Seat

Now Mary stood outside the tomb crying. As she wept, she bent over to look into the tomb and saw two angels in white, seated where Jesus' body had been, one at the head and the other at the foot (verse 11-12)

• Where else in the Bible do we see two angels, one at the head and one at the foot? (Exodus 25:17-19)

4. Seeing But Not Seeing

"She turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not realize that it was Jesus" (verse 14).

• The idea of resurrection was not part of Mary's paradigm / worldview.

5. Go And Tell

Mary Magdalene went to the disciples with the news: "I have seen the Lord!" And she told them that he had said these things to her (verse 18).

• Have you seen the Lord?: Go and tell!
