I have *loved* you with an everlasting love; therefore I have continued my faithfulness to you.

02. a child of God

See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called *children of God*; and so we are.

-1 John 3:1



03. delighted in

The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; *he will rejoice over you with gladness*; he will quiet you by his love; he will exult over you with loud singing.

-Zephaniah 3:17



04. free

For freedom Christ has set us *free*; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

-Galatians 5:1



05. a new creation

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is *a new creation*. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

-2 Corinthians 5:17



06. whole in Christ

For in him *the whole fullness* of deity dwells bodily and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority.

-Colossians 2:9-10

07. not hidden

My frame was *not hidden* from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth.

-Psalm 139:15



08. wonderfully made

I praise you, for I am fearfully and *wonderfully made*. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well.

09. a masterpiece

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

-Ephesians 2:10



10. never alone

It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed.

11. a friend of Jesus

No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you *friends*, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you.

In him we have redemption through his blood, the *forgiveness* of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace.

21. zealous

...who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are *zealous* for good works. -Titus 2:14



22. an ambassador


